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“MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2013-06

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL MOTORCYCLE DEALERS OR SHOPS BASED IN THE MUNICIPALITY TO CAUSE THE REGISTRATION OF MOTORCYCLES SOLD TO ANY RESIDENT OF THE MUNICIPALITY WITH THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICES IN THE PROVINCE.

WHEREAS, there are residents of the municipality who have been complaining that their motor vehicles were registered with Land Transportation Offices outside the province;

WHEREAS, there are cases where the registration of those new motor vehicles, change of classification (from private to for-hire or from for-hire to private), change of ownership, or renewal of registration of those motor vehicles with Land Transportation Offices are being processed by motorcycle dealers or shops with the Land Transportation Offices outside the province;

WHEREAS, change of classification (from private to for-hire or from for-hire to private), change of ownership, or renewal of registration of those motor vehicles with Land Transportation Offices outside the province have caused them undue difficulty, burden and inconveniences in the inspection of motor vehicles, processing of certificate of registration and/or payment of fees;

WHEREAS, there is a need to enact this ordinance in order to provide assistance to the residents of the municipality and for the interest of the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Title. – This ordinance shall be known as an “Ordinance Requiring All Motorcycle Dealers or Shops Based in the Municipality to Cause the Registration of Motorcycles Sold to Any Resident of the Municipality with the Land Transportation Offices in the Province.”

SECTION 2. Application. – This ordinance shall cover all motorcycle dealers or shops based in the municipality.

SECTION 3. Registration of Motor Vehicles. – All motorcycle dealers or shops based in the municipality are required to cause the registration of motorcycles sold to any resident of the municipality with the Land Transportation Offices in the province only within a period of three (3) months from the date of acquisition including the change of classification of motorcycle from private to for-hire.

SECTION 4. Penalty. – Any motorcycle dealer or shop or person tasked to register the motor vehicles who violates the provision of this ordinance shall be held liable and responsible per unit as follows:

First Offense – One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) and directed to cause the registration of motorcycle with the Land Transportation Offices situated in the province. The penalty shall apply after the lapse of three months as specified in Section 3 hereof.

Second Offense - One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00) and directed to cause the registration of motorcycle with the Land Transportation Offices situated in the province. The penalty shall apply after the lapse of one (1) months from the time the offender is held liable for first offense under this ordinance.

Third Offense - Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00), directed to cause the registration of motorcycle with the Land Transportation Offices situated in the province, and cancellation of business permit and license. The penalty shall apply after the lapse of one (1) month from the time the offender is held liable for second offense under this ordinance.

SECTION 5. Offices Responsible. – The Committee on Transportation and Committee of Franchising of the Sangguniang Bayan and the Municipal Treasury Office shall oversee the strict implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. Separability Clause. - If, for any reason any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. Repealing Clause. - Any ordinances, rules and regulation found inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and amended accordingly.


SECTION 8. Effectivity Claus. - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
