“MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2014-01

“AN ORDINANCE CONFERRING COMMENDATIONS, CITATIONS OR AWARDS FOR THE BEST PERFORMING BARANGAY UNITS OR ITS COUNCILS OR CIVIL SOCIETY GROUPS, AND FOR THE OUTSTANDING BARANGAY OFFICIALS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, ILOCOS NORTE, DEFINING ITS NATURE, PROVIDING THE GUIDELINES THERETO AND OTHER RELATED PURPOSES.

“Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan in session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. *Title.* This ordinance shall be referred to as the “*Barangay Governance Performance Awards and Citations Ordinance of the Municipality of San Nicolas*”.

SECTION 2. *Statement of Principles and Objectives.* The Municipality recognizes the indispensable role of every barangay as the primary unit of government policies, plans, programs, projects, and activities in the community, and as a forum wherein the collective views of the people may be expressed, crystallized and considered, and where disputes may be amicably settled.

Toward this end, there is a need to continuously encourage the barangay, including civil society groups who are likewise supportive to the programs of the Municipality, to effectively perform their holistic role in all areas of community-building.

The Municipality, in order to instill greater inspiration and motivation for exemplary governance practices of the barangays within its jurisdiction, including supportive organizations, it is best to adopt a policy that grant awards of appreciation and citations of commendation to the outstanding performances of barangay officials and individuals in all areas of public service.

SECTION 3. *Nature of Awards and Citations* – The Municipality shall vest awards or citations annually on the following:

Page 2, Municipal Ordinance No. 2014-01;

- I. For the Barangay as a Unit -
 - a. Best Performing Barangay Based on the State of Barangay Governance Report (SBGR)
 - b. Best Performing Barangay on Local Legislation;
 - c. Best Barangay Peace and Order Council; and
 - d. Best Performing Barangay *Lupon Tagapamayapa*; and
 - e. Best Performing Barangay Youth Council of the Year.

- II. For Barangay Officials/Individuals –
 - a. Most Outstanding Punong Barangay of the Year;
 - b. Most Outstanding Barangay Secretary of the Year;
 - c. Most Outstanding Barangay Tanod of the Year;
 - d. Most Outstanding Barangay Treasurer of the Year; and
 - e. Most Outstanding Barangay Lupon Member of the Year.

- III. For barangay volunteer groups or other civil society organizations. A citation of commendation shall be given to all recognized group who had unselfishly contributed and supported the implementation of programs and projects of the municipality in the onset of any “*bayanihan*” work, blood letting, and similar activities;

The aforesaid awardees shall be given a trophy and a *Sangguniang Bayan* Resolution of Conferment of Appreciation or Citation of Commendation to the selected barangay unit or individual, which shall be given during one of the affairs in the celebration of the Municipal Town Fiesta.

SECTION 4. *Creation of Selection Committee.* – There is hereby created a Selection Committee (SC) which shall be composed of the following:

- a. The Municipal Local Chief Executive (LCE) as the Chairman;
- b. The Municipal Local Government Operations Officer as Co-Chairman;
- c. The Chairman of the Committee on Laws, Rules, Ethics and Privileges of the Sangguniang Bayan as Member;
- d. The Chairman of the Committee on Peace and Order of the Sangguniang Bayan as Member;
- e. The ABC President of the *Liga Ng Mga Barangay*;
- f. The Secretary of the Sangguniang Bayan;
- g. The Municipal Administrator as Member;
- h. The Municipal Accountant as Member;
- i. A representative from the education sector;
- j. A representative from an accredited socio-civic groups;
- k. A representative of the business sector; and
- l. A representative from the retired government employees;

The aforesaid Selection Committee shall have no compensation or honorarium whatsoever.

The Selection Committee shall determine and recommend the conferment of the awards or citations to the deserving barangay unit, officials and other groups, to the *Sangguniang Bayan* for the enactment of pertinent Resolution as required in Section 3 hereof.

The Selection Committee shall be constituted by the Local Chief Executive not later than sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Ordinance, and shall be called to a meeting whenever necessary to carry out their herein stated functions.

SECTION 5. *Delegation of Authority for the Adoption of Criteria in the Selection of Awardees and its Implementing Rules.* – The Selection Committee is hereby authorized to adopt the criteria for the conferment of said awards or citations based on existing policies,

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guidelines and regulations set by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) in the selection of analogous awards with due regard to the policies of administrative transparency, efficiency, accountability, and other sound governmental practices. It shall consider recognized achievements, innovative approaches and creativity in barangay governance, and community participation in the implementation of different programs and projects.

In addition, the Selection Committee shall adopt and promulgate pertinent rules and regulations for the implementation of this Ordinance within the framework of the purposes and objectives herein set forth.

Within fifteen (15) days from its adoption, the criteria and related rules and regulations shall be furnished all barangays of the Municipality for their guidance and information.

SECTION 6. *Funding Requirements.* The funds necessary for its implementation shall come from voluntary sponsors, solicitations and donations obtained during the yearly Municipal Town Fiesta.

SECTION 7. *Effectivity.* This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its approval.
