“MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2014-06

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING FREE MOVIE PRIVILEGES TO QUALIFIED SENIOR CITIZENS OF THE MUNICIPALITY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it Enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall be known as “Senior Citizens Free Movie Privilege Ordinance of the Municipality of San Nicolas.”

SECTION 2. Statement of Objectives. – The government recognizes the invaluable contributions of Senior Citizens in the well-being of families and the development of the community where they have dedicated their lives. The municipality appreciates with utmost gratitude their accomplishments which is now one of the sources of inspiration for today’s youth and leaders. Consistent with the declared national policy of promoting the welfare of the elderlies and senior citizens as enunciated in the various laws adopted by Congress of the Philippines, the Municipality, encourages entities and business establishments, particularly movie houses, theaters and cinemas to focus some of their programs under their corporate social responsibility in granting special accommodation to qualified senior citizens in the form of free movie privilege, as a way of promoting the care and assistance to them.

Thus, this Ordinance aims:

- a) To re-affirm the valued Filipino tradition of caring for the elderlies;
- b) To give full support and meaning to the needs of elderlies for the quality recreation and entertainment at the least expense to them;
- c) To provide an effective mechanism and cooperation of the business community particularly, movie houses and theater owners and operators, to support programs for the elderlies; and
- d) To institute an active partnership of the Municipality, Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs and the private sector in the improvement of the welfare of the elderlies and differently-abled persons.

SECTION 3. Grant of Privilege. - Pursuant to Section 2 hereof, a privilege which shall be known as a Free Movie Privilege can be availed of by any qualified senior citizen of the preferred participating movie houses in the municipality.

SECTION 4. Coverage. – All senior citizens recognized by the municipality as qualified shall enjoy the privilege of watching a movie for free from any of the participating movie houses in the municipality.

SECTION 5. Qualifications. – Any senior citizen is entitled to a free movie privilege provided he/she meets the following requirements:

- a) He/she must be a resident of the municipality for at least one (1) year from the date of availment of privilege;
- b) He/she must be registered voter of the municipality; and
- c) He/she is a bona-fide member of senior citizens association in the Barangay as duly noted in the office of the senior citizens affairs.

SECTION 6. Mechanism and Procedures. – Once a senior citizen is recognized as qualified to avail of the free movie privilege, he/shall be issued a specially designed Identification Card by the Office of the Mayor in coordination with the Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs which shall serve as his/her pass for his/her entrance together with his/her Senior Citizen's Identification Card.

Qualified senior citizen must personally transact with movie house establishment personnel.

SECTION 7. Participating Movie Houses and Theaters. – The Municipality, through the Office of the Local Chief Executive/Mayor, shall enter into a memorandum of agreement with the movie houses owners and operators which shall allow free movie privilege of qualified senior citizens into their preferred participating movie houses and theaters.

Said Memorandum of Agreement shall lay down the specific days in a week that the senior citizens can avail of said free movie privilege and such other terms and conditions necessary to its implementation subject to the approval of the Sangguniang Bayan. For this purpose, the Local Chief Executive/Mayor is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into such reasonable terms and conditions within the framework of the objectives of this ordinance at the least expense of the Municipality.

SECTION 8. Reciprocal Incentives of Participating Movie Houses and Theaters. The participating Movie Houses and Theaters who have directed their corporate social responsibility funds in providing free movie privileges to qualified senior citizens under this Ordinance may claim or avail incentives from the municipality pursuant to Section 4 of Municipal Ordinance No. 2011-15 otherwise known as “An Ordinance Institutionalizing Corporate Social Responsibility Among Large Taxpayer Corporations and Other Business Establishments and Providing Incentives Therefor”.

SECTION 9. Separability Clause. - If, for any reason any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. Repealing Clause. - Any ordinances, rules and regulation found inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and amended accordingly.

SECTION 11. Effectivity Clause. - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


