“MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2017-03

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE SEARCH FOR THE WELL-INFORMED STUDENTS AND TEACHERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, ILOCOS NORTE.

SECTION 1. *Title.* – This Ordinance shall be known as an “Ordinance Institutionalizing the Search for the Well-Informed Students and Teachers of the Municipality of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte.”

SECTION 2. *Declaration of Principles and Policies.* – The municipality hereby advocates the principles and policies as laid down under the 1987 Philippine Constitution, Article XIV Sections 1 and 3 as follows: “Section 1. The state shall protect and promote the right of all the citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all and Section 3 (2) They shall inculcate patriotism and nationalism, foster love of humanity, respect for human rights, appreciation of the role of national heroes in the historical development of the country, teach the rights and duties of citizenship, strengthen ethical and spiritual values, develop moral character and personal discipline, encourage critical and creative thinking, broaden scientific and technological knowledge and promote efficiency.”

SECTION 3. *Institutionalization of the Search.* – The Search for the Well-Informed Students and Teachers is hereby institutionalized to ensure its sustainability within the context of literacy and continuing education program of the municipality that geared towards excellence, the foundations for learning throughout life, the competence to engage in work and be productive, the ability to coexist in fruitful harmony with local and global communities, the capability to engage in autonomous, creative, and critical thinking, and the capacity and willingness to transform others and one’s self and where San Nicoleños can become productive and responsible citizens equipped with the essential competencies, skills and values for both life-long learning and employment.

For this purpose, the Search entails the “love of reading” where participants must have the passion and fascination on current events and History of San Nicolas.

SECTION 4. *Guidelines and Mechanics of the Search.* – The Municipal Literacy Coordinating Council (MLCC), in collaboration and consultation with Stakeholders, shall promulgate guidelines and mechanics for the conduct of the search.

The Search will be in the form of written and/or oral examination, individually and/or team.

The conduct of the search shall form part of the celebration of annual Damili Festival.

SECTION 5. Funding Requirement. – Fund shall come from the available and related programs on literacy of the municipal government. Thereafter, it shall be included in the municipal Annual Budget or to subsequent annual appropriations.

SECTION 6. Separability Clause. - If for any reason, any section of this Ordinance is declared illegal or unconstitutional, other sections hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. Repealing Clause. - All previous issuances, ordinance, rules and regulations, provisions or parts thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 8. Effectivity. - This ordinance shall take immediately upon approval.


