“MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2017-05

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1, ARTICLE A, CHAPTER XVII OF MUNICIPAL
ORDINANCE NO. 2009-12 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE CODE OF GENERAL ORDINANCES
OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, ILOCOS NORTE.**

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1., Article A, Chapter XVII of Municipal Ordinance No. 2009-12 provides that:

Designated Sons and Daughters to be Honored. – The following are the designated sons and daughters to be honored with a necrological program:

- a. Municipal Mayors;
- b. Vice-Mayors;
- c. Members of the Municipal Council or Sangguniang Bayan of the municipality;
- d. Punong Barangays;
- e. Policemen and Soldiers from this municipality who died while in the active duty or after retirement;
- f. Spouse of Municipal Mayor who played active role during his administration;
- g. Judges and Justices with good standing from this municipality,
- h. Public School Teachers who are natives of and served in this municipality who died while in active service or after retirement;
- i. Municipal Health Officer or Rural Health Unit Doctor who is a native of and served in this municipality who died while in active service or after retirement;
- j. Veteran, who is a member of the Veterans Federation of the Philippines, San Nicolas Post;
- k. Inducted US Veterans; and
- l. Such other qualified sons and daughters of the municipality to be determined by the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION 2. Article A, Chapter XVII of Municipal Ordinance No. 2009-12 is hereby amended, to wit:

- a. The persons enumerated in Section 1 shall remain but the following shall be included to be granted a Necrological Service at the Municipal Hall building.
 - a.1 Municipal Department Heads who dies during his tenure of office or retired in the Public Service.
 - a.2 Bureau of Fire Personnel who are natives of San Nicolas, served in this municipality and those who died while in active service or after retirement.
 - a.3 San Nicolense of the Year Awardees Local.

SECTION 3. Repealing Clause. - All previous issuances, ordinance, rules and regulations, provisions or parts thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 4. Separability Clause. - If for any reason, any section of this Ordinance is declared illegal or unconstitutional, other sections hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 5. Effectivity Clause. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
