“RESOLUTION NO. 2017-101

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, HON. ALFREDO P. VALDEZ, JR. TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE LAOAG CITY GENERAL HOSPITAL (LCGH) FOR THE FACILITATION OF THE PROVISION OF MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO PATIENTS ADMITTED IN THE SAID HEALTH INSTITUTION.

WHEREAS, the Laoag City General Hospital, a health care facility that adheres and fully support the Universal Health Care Program of the national government wherein it is aimed that every Filipino must have access to health care especially for the indigent segments of society through the adoption and implementation of the Philippine Health Insurance Corporations' (PHIC) Point of Care Program (POC);

WHEREAS, LCGH statistics for FY2012 – FY2016 indicate a growing number of non-PHIC indigent patients coming from the different Municipalities of Ilocos Norte who are availing of the LCGH services especially on confinement;

WHEREAS, there is an existing memorandum of agreement executed by the Laoag City General Hospital and the Municipality of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte, and the continued availment of medical services of indigent segment from the Municipality of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte, at the Laoag City General Hospital will ensure the inflow of patients that otherwise would not form part of the regular clientele of the hospital;

WHEREAS, the LCGH seeks to implement mutually beneficial health programs with the LGUs thru the establishment of Trust Funds from LGU's where these indigent patients are residents of solely for their enrolment to the PHIC;

WHEREAS, Sec. 22(c) of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, provides, that:

Sec. 22. Corporate Powers. – (a) Every local government unit, as a corporation, shall have the following powers:

xxx

xxx

xxx

(c) Unless otherwise provided in this Code, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the sanggunian concerned. A legible copy of such contract shall be posted at a conspicuous place in the provincial capitol or the city, municipal or barangay hall.

WHEREAS, the municipal mayor is empowered by the same Code to enter into contracts on behalf of the municipality, based on Section 444(b)(1)(vi) thereof which provides:

Section 444. The Chief Executive: Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation.
– xxx

(b) For efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code, the municipal mayor shall:

(vi) Upon authorization by the sangguniang bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance.”

WHEREAS, after thorough deliberation and consideration of the members of the Sangguniang Bayan, it was:

RESOLVED as it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to authorize the Local Chief Executive, Honorable Alfredo P. Valdez, Jr. to Enter Into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Laoag City General Hospital (LCGH) for the Facilitation of the Provision of Medical Assistance to Patients Admitted in the said Health Institution.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to transcribe copies of this resolution to the Local Chief Executive and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action;


On joint motion of Members Orlando B. Badua, duly seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.


