“RESOLUTION NO. 2017-163

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE IDENTIFIED TOURISM SITES, DESTINATIONS, AND ENTERPRISES SITUATED WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY FOR PURPOSES OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF COMPREHENSIVE TOURISM PLAN, POTENTIAL INCLUSION FOR THE GRANT OF INCENTIVES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act 9593 also known as “The Tourism Act of 2009” declares the policy of the State as follows: “The State declares tourism as an indispensable element of the national economy and an industry of national interest and importance, which must be harnessed as an engine of socio-economic growth and cultural affirmation to generate investment, foreign exchange and employment, and to continue to mold an enhanced sense of national pride for all Filipinos”;

WHEREAS, the municipality takes pride for its rich cultural heritage, considerable investment by business sector, and agricultural best practices that are being capitalized or used for significant tourism activities;

WHEREAS, in 2015, San Nicolas has the largest concentration of tourism enterprises (accommodation, travel agencies, food, shopping) in the province with a total revenue of P743,079,995.55 while other towns with significant tourism activities have generated the following income, to wit: Pagudpud - P 6,576,143, Currimao - P 435,942.99, Paoay - P125,946.66 (*Source: Ilocos Norte Tourism Office’s entry to 2016 LGU Best Tourism Oriented - ATOP Pearl Award*);

WHEREAS, by adopting the below mentioned tourism sites and destinations, it will further ensure the development of municipality’s tourism, conserve and promote the heritage, instill municipal identity and sense of unity and improve the quality of life of the San Nicoleños, provide appropriate attention and support for the growth of tourism industry, encourage private sector participation, and aid the local government unit in advocating the grant of none fiscal incentives;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to adopt the identified tourist sites and destinations situated within the municipality for purposes of the development of comprehensive tourism plan, potential inclusion for the grant of incentives and other purposes, as follows:

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the local government unit shall commit itself for the preservation and conservation of the cultural properties abound in the municipality which can be used for sustainable development;


