“RESOLUTION NO. 2017-173

A RESOLUTION CONVEYING THE SINCEREST GRATITUDE OF THE PEOPLE OF SAN NICOLAS, ILOCOS NORTE, TO MR. ANTONIO CALIPJO GO, THE ACADEMIC SUPERVISOR OF MARIAN SCHOOL OF QUEZON CITY AND A “SICKBOOK CRUSADER” FOR REVIEWING “READ AND LEAD”, A SUPPLEMENTARY READER FOR ENGLISH GRADE V”, OWNED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS AND WRITTEN BY MRS. LUVIMINA A. CALUPIG.

WHEREAS, it has been a declared national policy to promote the moral and intellectual well-being of the people: elevate the literacy level of every Filipino to the end that illiteracy is eradicated by the end of the century; and recognize the vital role of knowledge and information in nation-building by establishing public libraries in every congressional district, city and municipality, and reading centers in every barangay throughout the Philippines;

WHEREAS, after painstakingly working on the second edition of the book, Mrs. Luvimina V.
