**“RESOLUTION NO. 2016-243**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE TO DEPUTIZE THE TEN (10) TERMINAL PRESIDENTS OF THE TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION IN FURTHERANCE TO THE MAINTENANCE OF ORDER IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF TRAFFIC LAWS, ORDINANCES AND RELATED ISSUANCES, WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, ILOCOS NORTE.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Local Government Code, the Sangguniang Bayan as the law-making body of the Local Government Unit (LGU) has the authority and power to enact resolutions and ordinances for a more orderly flow of traffic in its jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, apparently the Municipality has grown tremendously in terms of economic development where business is thriving in an unprecedented pace but not without bringing with it traffic congestions especially in busy areas such as the public market and the business centers at Brgy. 1, San Francisco;

**WHEREAS**, the present administration with the PNP at the forefront, has previously devised plans to ease these areas of traffic disorder and bottlenecks. The LGU even had to increase the number of traffic enforcers by providing funds in the hiring of the added personnel;

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Bayan is of the belief that there is a need to augment the strength of the personnel manning and managing the smooth flow of traffic by deputizing the ten (10) Terminal Presidents of the Tricycle Operators and Drivers in the Municipality;

**WHEREAS**, the compensation of the additional personnel shall be determined by the Local Chief Executive which will come from the allocated funds in the Peace and Order Program of the LGU, subject to limitations provided for by law;

**WHEREFORE**, be it **RESOLVED** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session to authorize the Local Chief Executive to deputize the ten (10) Terminal Presidents of the TODA as traffic enforcers who will help in the implementation of existing traffic laws and ordinances within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of San Nicolas, Province of Ilocos Norte;

**RESOLVED FURTHER** to transcribe a copy of this resolution and forward same to the Local Chief Executive for his appropriate action.


On motion of Member Efren C. Butay, duly seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.
