A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SINCEREST SYMPATHY AND HEARTFELT CONDOLENCES OF THE PEOPLE OF SAN NICOLAS, ILOCOS NORTE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF MRS. FORTUNA “BABY” MARCOS BARBA, A PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHER AND A CIVIC SPIRITED AND GENEROUS BENEFACTOR OF THE TOWN AND A VERY LOVING MOTHER AND WIFE.

WHEREAS, Mrs. Fortuna Marcos Barba is the youngest daughter of Mariano Marcos and Josefa Edralin and the favorite sibling of the late President Ferdinand E. Marcos;

WHEREAS, Mrs. Fortuna Marcos was married to General Marcelino Barba, a San Nicoleño, and were blessed with eight (8) children including the incumbent Vice-Governor of the Province of Ilocos Norte, and a former Mayor of the Municipality of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte, Honorable Angelo Marcos Barba;

WHEREAS, the death of Mrs. Fortuna Marcos Barba brought a pall of sadness not only to her immediate family members but to many friends and relatives, especially San Nicoleños whose lives were interlaced with her family’s love and affection;

WHEREAS, in many occasions, Mrs. Baby Barba was very active, participating in the affairs and activities of the Municipality of San Nicolas, more so during fiestas and other significant occasions; Her husband, the then Colonel Marcelino Barba, was at the forefront of development of the town, and the acknowledged intermediary in the construction of the FEM Mini-Cultural and Sports Center, the Tennis Court and an Olympic-sized swimming pool, all located north of the Roman Catholic Church;

WHEREAS, Mrs. Barba is known as a humble and self-effacing lady, that inspite of her being the favorite sibling of the late President Ferdinand Marcos, she never involved herself in politics and chose to focus and devote her time to her family; She too, is a sports buff, a tennis and horseback riding enthusiast;

WHEREAS, her stature and energy are worthy of emulation, thus, it is but fitting and proper to accord her great respect and honor;

WHEREAS, our municipality shall always remember Mrs. Fortuna “Baby” Marcos Barba, the likes of whom we shall not have the privilege to know and see again for a long long time;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Bayan in session to express the sincerest sympathy and heartfelt condolences of the people of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte to the Bereaved Family.
