Mamuad is known as a jolly good fellow, a humble and self-effacing person, a kind brother and a courageous religious leader, that despite the many difficulties he encountered in his service to the Lord, including his time of retirement, he remained an obedient son of God, steadfast in his belief that God is just, the all prevailing and supreme master, the source of everything including the spirit that giveth eternal life;

**WHEREAS**, the town of San Nicolas is so grateful for having a son like Fr. Mamuad who is looked upon as a source of inspiration, worthy for every San Nicoleño to emulate;

**WHEREAS**, our municipality shall always remember Fr. Mamuad, the likes of whom we shall not have the privilege to know and see again for a long long time;


