“MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2018-10

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE SCHOOL AND CLASSROOM FIRE MARSHALS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, ILOCOS NORTE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

SECTION 1. *Title.* – This ordinance shall be known as the “School and Classroom Fire Marshals”.

SECTION 2. *Declaration of Policy.* – This ordinance declares the policy of the municipality to protect the life, limb, and property of every individual by instilling the sense of volunteerism against any form of disaster and organizing volunteer groups in the schools necessary to protect life and prevent or suppress disaster.

The promotion of the involvement and participation of all sectors and all stakeholders concerned, at all levels, especially the local community is crucial to address disaster management.

SECTION 3. *Institutionalization of School and Classroom Fire Marshall.* – There shall be a School and Classroom Fire Marshals, acting as volunteer group, to be supervised by the class advisers and school heads or principals.

The Municipal Disaster Risk and Management Officer and the Bureau of Fire Protection shall conduct the necessary and relevant trainings and seminars of students and teachers involved pursuant to existing laws, rules, and regulations.

The qualifications and functions of classroom and school fire marshals shall be stated and governed in the operational guidelines to be issued jointly by the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council and San Nicolas Bureau of Fire Protection necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. *Funding Requirement.* – The funds necessary for the implementation of this program shall come from available fund of the municipal government.

SECTION 5. *Separability Clause.* - If for any reason, any section of this Ordinance is declared illegal or unconstitutional, other sections hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. Repealing Clause. - All previous issuances, ordinance, rules and regulations, provisions or parts thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 7. Effectivity. - This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after posting the same in the Bulletin Board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and two (2) other conspicuous places in the municipality.
