“RESOLUTION NO. 2018-447

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, HON. ALFREDO P. VALDEZ, JR. TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE CDEA ENTERPRISES, INC. REPRESENTED BY MR. JAMES FRANCIS L. ANG FOR THE WASTE DIVERSION AND RESOURCE RECOVERY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, PROVINCE OF ILOCOS NORTE.

WHEREAS, it is the mandate of the establishment to adhere to the Solid Waste Management Program of the municipality of San Nicolas;

WHEREAS, the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 (RA 9003), provides for an Ecological Solid Waste Management System, creating the necessary institutional mechanisms and incentives, and appropriating funds thereof to guide local government units (LGUs) in the achievement of the objectives of the Act;

WHEREAS, Section 20 of RA 9003 requires LGUs to divert solid waste from waste disposal facilities through re-use, recycling and composting and other resource recovery activities;

WHEREAS, in order for LGUs to fulfill one of their responsibilities to divert solid wastes from the waste stream, the CDEA Enterprises, Inc. supports the Resource Recovery Program of the municipality under its Solid Waste Management Program through donation of its rice hull wastes generated from the operation of the business and a rice hull carbonizer machine to facilitate the production of fertilizer i.e. carbonized rice hull.

WHEREAS, the output will be used to fertilize seedlings/saplings in the Municipal Nursery as it can increase the temperature of the soil, loosen the soil and adjust the pH value of the soil, hence, carbonized rice hull will serve as soil conditioner.

WHEREAS, Sec. 22(c) of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, provides, that:

Sec. 22. Corporate Powers. – (a) Every local government unit, as a corporation, shall have the following powers:

xxx

xxx

xxx

(c) Unless otherwise provided in this Code, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the sanggunian concerned. A legible copy of such contract shall be posted at a conspicuous place in the provincial capitol or the city, municipal or barangay hall.

WHEREAS, the municipal mayor is empowered by the same Code to enter into contracts on behalf of the municipality, based on Section 444(b)(1)(vi) thereof which provides:

Section 444. The Chief Executive: Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation.
– xxx

(b) For efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code, the municipal mayor shall:

(vi) Upon authorization by the sangguniang bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance.”

WHEREAS, after thorough deliberation and consideration of the members of the Sangguniang Bayan, it was:

RESOLVED as it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to authorize the Local Chief Executive, Hon. Alfredo P. Valdez, Jr. to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the CDEA Enterprises, Inc. Represented by Mr. James Francis L. Ang for the Waste Diversion and Resource Recovery in the Municipality of San Nicolas, Province of Ilocos Norte.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to transcribe copies of this resolution to the Local Chief Executive and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action;


On motion of Member Manuel D. Coloma, Sr., seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.
