**“RESOLUTION NO. 2018-458**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, HON. ALFREDO P. VALDEZ, JR. TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE SAN NICOLAS MUNICIPAL POLICE STATION REPRESENTED BY PCI PAUL BENEDICT R. PARADO, LIGA NG MGA BARANGAY – SAN NICOLAS REPRESENTED BY ITS PRESIDENT HON. JUANITO P. ULEP, JR. AND THE NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION REGIONAL OFFICE NO. I REPRESENTED BY ITS REGIONAL DIRECTOR, DIR. EVANGELINE R. ALMIRANTE, MNSA, CESO V FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMMUNITY AND SERVICE-ORIENTED POLICING (CSOP) SYSTEM.**

**WHEREAS**, the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) is constitutionally mandated to administer and control the Philippine National Police (PNP);

**WHEREAS**, Section 64 of the Republic Act No. 8551 provides that the Governors and Mayors, upon having been elected and having qualified as such, are automatically “deputized as representatives of the NAPOLCOM in their respective jurisdiction”;

**WHEREAS**, Section 2 of RA 8551 provides that the PNP shall be a community and service service-oriented agency responsible for the maintenance of peace and order and public safety;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to said provision of the law, the NAPOLCOM issued Resolution No. 2015-342 entitled, “Resolution to Empower the Philippine National Police (PNP) to Perform its Role as a Community and Service-Oriented Agency through the Adoption of the Community and Service-Oriented Policing (CSOP) System involving the Local Chief Executives, the PNP and the Community, as mandated under Section 2 of RA No. 6975, as amended by RA No. 8551;

**WHEREAS**, the NAPOLCOM issued an Implementing Guidelines for Municipal Community and Service-Oriented Policing (CSOP) System in response to the need for a practical guide for the police and local government executives in putting into operation the CSOP System;

**WHEREAS**, the CSOP System ensures the establishment of a coordinative and cooperative mechanism through a triumvirate composed of the Local Chief Executives (LCEs), Chiefs of Police (COP) and Community Leaders in the area;

**WHEREAS**, Sec. 22(c) of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, provides, that:

*Sec. 22. Corporate Powers. – (a) Every local government unit, as a corporation, shall have the following powers:*

xxx xxx xxx

Page 2, Resolution No. 2018-458;

(c) Unless otherwise provided in this Code, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the sanggunian concerned. A legible copy of such contract shall be posted at a conspicuous place in the provincial capitol or the city, municipal or barangay hall.

**WHEREAS**, the municipal mayor is empowered by the same Code to enter into contracts on behalf of the municipality, based on Section 444(b)(1)(vi) thereof which provides:

Section 444. The Chief Executive: Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation. –  
xxx

(b) For efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code, the municipal mayor shall:

(vi) Upon authorization by the sangguniang bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance.”

**WHEREAS**, after thorough deliberation and consideration of the members of the Sangguniang Bayan, it was:

**RESOLVED** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to authorize the Local Chief Executive, Hon. Alfredo P. Valdez, Jr. to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the San Nicolas Municipal Police Station Represented by PCI Paul Benedict R. Parado, Liga ng mga Barangay – San Nicolas Represented by its President Hon. Juanito P. Ulep, Jr. and the National Police Commission Regional Office No. I represented by its Regional Director, Dir. Evangeline R. Almirante, MNSA, CESO V for the implementation of the Community and Service-Oriented Policing (CSOP) System.

**RESOLVED, FURTHER**, to transcribe copies of this resolution to the Local Chief Executive and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action;

On motion of Member Orlando B. Badua, duly seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.


