“MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2019-06

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THE VALDES-LARDIZABAL HOUSE AS BALAY SAN NICOLAS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2018, the Sangguniang Bayan passed and adopted Sangguniang Bayan Resolution No. 2018-733 entitled, *“A Resolution Earnestly Requesting the National Historical Commission of the Philippines to Approve or Cause Appropriate Action for the Renaming of the Valdes-Lardizabal House into Balay San Nicolas;”*

WHEREAS, the said Resolution posits that considering that it is now owned by the municipal government, *“there is a need to rename the said property from Valdes-Lardizabal House to Balay San Nicolas in order to appropriately represent and manifest the San Nicoleños’ love and fervor to history, culture, heritage, patrimony, and sense of identity;”*

WHEREAS, in its reply dated November 27, 2018, the National Historical Commission of the Philippines *“does not object to the renaming based on the thorough deliberations of the Sangguniang Bayan of San Nicolas;”*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. The Valdes-Lardizabal House also known as “Old House” declared as Important Cultural Property of the Philippines by the National Museum situated at Barangay 2, San Baltazar, San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte is hereby renamed as the “Balay San Nicolas”.

SECTION 2. Authority of the Local Chief Executive. – The Local Chief Executive is hereby granted an authority to transact, negotiate, or enter into an agreement or understanding for and on behalf of the municipal government with persons, organizations, or entity for the proper conservation and utilization of the property.

SECTION 3. Appropriation. – The municipal government shall include in its Annual Investment Program and annual budget the funds necessary for the conservation and promotion of the property for cultural heritage, tourism, and related programs.

SECTION 4. Separability Clause. - If for any reason, any section of this Ordinance is declared illegal or unconstitutional, other sections hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. Repealing Clause. - All previous issuances, ordinance, rules and regulations, provisions or parts thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 6. Effectivity. - This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after posting the same in the Bulletin Board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and two (2) other conspicuous places in the municipality.


