### **“RESOLUTION NO. 2019-106**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, HON. ALFREDO P. VALDEZ, JR. TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT BUREAU (EMB) REGION I AND THE SAN NICOLAS NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL ECO SAVERS PROGRAM (NEP) AT THE SAN NICOLAS NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL SPECIFICALLY ON WASTE DIVERSION AND RESOURCE RECOVERY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine Ecological Solid Waste Management Act (RA 9003) provides the legal framework for promoting the systematic, comprehensive and ecological measures for avoiding the generation of solid waste, reducing wastes and final safe disposing for waste in order to protect public health and the environment;

**WHEREAS**, Section 8 of RA 9003, mandates the DENR to, among others, provide technical and other capability building assistance and support to the Local Government Units (LGU) in the development and implementation of local solid waste management plans and programs;

**WHEREAS**, the DENR fosters the strategy of partnerships among stakeholders such as government agencies, non-government organization (NGOs), the youth in the private and public sector in the promotion of Ecological Solid Waste Management;

**WHEREAS**, Article 1 Section 2 of RA 9003 states that the Local Government Units (LGU) have the primary enforcement and responsibility of solid waste management while establishing a cooperative effort among the national government, other local government units, non-government organizations and the private sector;

**WHEREAS**, RA 9003 mandates the LGUs to provide efficient, reliable and universal collection service and environmentally safe disposal of wastes;

**WHEREAS**, the existing public school system within the LGU is valuable resource that can be tapped in the implementation of a local ecological solid waste management program.

**WHEREAS**, Sec. 22(c) of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, provides, that:

Sec. 22. Corporate Powers. – (a) Every local government unit, as a corporation, shall have the following powers:

xxx

xxx

xxx

(c) Unless otherwise provided in this Code, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the sanggunian concerned. A legible copy of such contract shall be posted at a conspicuous place in the provincial capitol or the city, municipal or barangay hall.

WHEREAS, the municipal mayor is empowered by the same Code to enter into contracts on behalf of the municipality, based on Section 444(b)(1)(vi) thereof which provides:

Section 444. The Chief Executive: Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation. – xxx

(b) For efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code, the municipal mayor shall:

(vi) Upon authorization by the sangguniang bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance.”

WHEREAS, after thorough deliberation and consideration of the members of the Sangguniang Bayan, it was:

RESOLVED as it is hereby RESOLVED by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to authorize the Local Chief Executive, Hon. Alfredo P. Valdez, Jr. to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) Region I and the San Nicolas National High School for the Implementation of the National Eco Savers Program (NEP) at the San Nicolas National High School Specifically on Waste Diversion and Resource Recovery.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to transcribe copies of this resolution to the Local Chief Executive and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action;


On motion of Member Manuel Cleto D. Coloma, Sr., duly seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.




