WHEREAS, Dr. Shirley B. Mina is a persistent, pro-active lady mentor who in almost her whole life dedicated her prime time in nurturing her students at the Mariano Marcos State University and now as a volunteer lecturer of teachers engaged in the blended learning system in this time of pandemic;

WHEREAS, in 1971, Dr. Shirley B. Mina finished her Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor in Secondary Education degrees at the Divine Word College of Laoag (1971, 1975), passed the teachers examination and started her illustrious career as a teacher at the Marcos High School and Catagtaguen Brgy, High School (1972-1975). She was then appointed as professor at the Mariano Marcos State University in 1975 where she retired in 2014.

WHEREAS, she did not stop learning and in order to enhance her teaching skills she pursued her Masters of Arts in Education at the Mariano Marcos State University and later on finished her Doctorate degree also at MMSU. She too was privileged to attend in 1991 a short term course English for Specific Purposes, at the Institute for Language Education at Lancaster University in England.

WHEREAS, after her retirement, she continued sharing her expertise at the Mary Cause of Joy Seminary and at the Northwestern University and offering her time especially to the activities of the municipal government in the field of education being an extension coordinator at MMSU. Having earned those exceptional academic and service records, it is no doubt that she is one of the most respected educators in the locality and known as a selfless, efficient and effective administrator in the academe; She too is considered as more than a teacher, as she also acted as a patient and caring mother to her students, to the school she served and to her peers in the teaching profession;

WHEREAS, in conferring to Dr. Shirley B. Mina the 2020 San Nicolense of the Year – Local, the municipality recognizes her deep sense of commitment in administering and providing quality education as a professor, her humility and industry, her dignified way of life, virtues and traits worthy for every San Nicoleño to emulate and be proud of;
