From thereon, he was assigned to various posts and camps as a member of US Air Force engaging the enemies in numerous battles and earning commendations and medals for his valor and bravery. Upon his retirement, he is still very active as a community leader and civic servant, offering his time without hesitation, in helping people in need, most especially the town he loves most; He donated books which he authored, and is helping the financially challenged students of San Nicolas.
