“MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2021-07

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PARKING AREA AT A PORTION OF LEAÑO AVENUE, THE HALF-LANE ADJOINING THE MUNICIPAL HALL BUILDING AND THE SAN NICOLAS PUBLIC PLAZA (STRETCH FROM MADAMBA AVENUE TO GENERAL LUNA ST.), THE ACCESS ROAD NORTH OF THE MUNICIPAL HALL, AND THE ROAD SHOULDER OF MADAMBA ROAD, SOUTH OF SAN NICOLAS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

Explanatory Note

The Municipality of San Nicolas without doubt is now the business center in the Province of Ilocos Norte. One huge mall is located in the sprawling Valdez Center and other notable establishments flourished, including world class Business Processing Outsourcing Centers and an IT park, an oasis type area where food centers are located. National Agency offices are now also holding offices at the Robinsons Mall, most notable of which is the DFA where people in the province and nearby areas need not to go far to secure their passports, the Professional Regulation Commission, the PAG-IBIG Mutual Fund and others.

It is inevitable though that traffic in the area worsened and congestions in strategic areas occurs during rush hours. Thus, the need to adopt strategies to ease the traffic situation is imperative, one of which is the establishment of parking areas and to clear the public roads of obstruction that hamper the smooth flow of traffic.

Towards this end, the Sangguniang Bayan deems it proper to pursue this program also within the premises of the Municipal Hall Building to benefit the clients coming to the offices for their needs.

WHEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang assembled in session, to ORDAIN, THAT:

SECTION 1. Short Title. This ordinance shall be also known as the “Parking Area Ordinance near the premises of the Municipal Hall Building of San Nicolas”.

SECTION 2. *Statement of policy.* It is the policy of the Municipal Government to maintain a smooth and orderly flow of traffic in its territorial jurisdiction, providing reasonable and attainable mechanisms to attain such goal.

SECTION 3. *Authority.* The Local Government Code of 1991 provides among others, that the Sangguniang Bayan through an ordinance can regulate the use of public roads within its territorial jurisdiction for the general welfare of its people, subject to limitations as may be provided by law.

SECTION 4. *Establishment of Parking Area.*

- a. A parking area is hereby established at a portion of Leaño Avenue, the half lane that adjoins the Municipal Hall Building and the San Nicolas Public Plaza, from the intersection at Madamba Road until the corner at Gen. Luna St. at Brgy. 2, San Balatazar.

The remaining half-lane of Leaño Avenue is hereby designated as one-way street going north from Madamba Road until the corner of General Luna St.

- b. The road shoulder of Madamba Road (South of San Nicolas, Elementary School.), and,
- c. The access road north of the Municipal Hall Building.

SECTION 5. *Vehicles allowed to park.* Only light vehicles are allowed to park in areas designated in letter (a) and (b) of the preceding section. Light vehicles refer to 4-wheeled vehicles/cars and the like.

The access road north of the Municipal Hall Building shall be the parking area of Motorcycles and tricycles.

Municipal vehicles of Municipal Officials and employees shall occupy a designated area to be assigned by proper authorities.

SECTION 6. *Implementation.* The PNP, through the traffic division including the traffic aides of the municipality, are hereby authorized to implement and apprehend violators of the provisions of this ordinance. Further, they shall devise mechanisms not contrary to the intent of this ordinance, in order to fully implement and attain the objective of this local regulation.

SECTION 7. *Penal Provision.* Any person/s violating this ordinance shall be meted with a fine of P500.00 on its first offense and not exceeding 1,000.00 in its second and succeeding infraction/s.

SECTION 8. *Separability Clause.* If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, or inconsistent with national law, rules and regulations, other provision not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect, the same shall prevail and all previous ordinances, rules, regulations, executive order or memoranda are hereby superseded and modified accordingly.


SECTION 9. *Effectivity.* This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and after compliance regarding its posting or publication shall be complied with as provided for by RA 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of the Philippines.
