“RESOLUTION NO. 2021-04

A RESOLUTION PRESCRIBING RULES AND GUIDELINES IN ALLOWING MEAT HANDLERS OF LAOAG CITY OR THEIR AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES TO HAVE THEIR HOGS BUTCHERED AT THE MUNICIPAL ABATTOIR OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, ILOCOS NORTE.

WHEREAS, the City of Laoag is experiencing a surge of Corona Virus cases prompting the Honorable Governor Matthew J. Marcos Manotoc to place the City under General Community Quarantine (GCQ);

WHEREAS, to contain the rise in cases, the Slaughterhouse of Laoag has ceased its operation paralyzing the meat handlers' business and consequently the butchers' livelihood;

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive of Laoag City, Honorable Michael Marcos Keon appealed and sought the assistance of nearby municipalities adjoining the city including San Nicolas, to accommodate and allow the meat handlers/butchers to have their hogs slaughtered in their respective abattoir;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Mayor Honorable Alfredo P. Valdez, Jr. out of compassion and to avoid discrimination of people coming to San Nicolas, accommodated the request of Laoag City Mayor Marcos-Keon with the condition that they have to comply faithfully with the rules and guidelines to be imposed by San Nicolas, so as to protect also the townspeople of the municipality;

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the above-foregoing, the following rules and guidelines are hereby imposed and prescribed to be observed by non-resident meat handlers/butchers of San Nicolas more particularly those from the City of Laoag of having their hogs butchered at the Municipal Slaughterhouse:

1. The San Nicolas Municipal Slaughterhouse will accommodate a maximum of four (4) meat handlers/butchers from Laoag City to transact business at the Municipal Slaughterhouse. They must present proper identification and must have NEGATIVE COVID 19 test (RT PCR test) result.
2. A maximum of twenty (20) hogs will be accommodated from 4:00 AM to 8:00 AM. All hogs subject for slaughter should be at the SN Slaughterhouse from 1:00 PM to 6:00 PM to allow resting/quarantine period from 6:00 PM to 12:00 midnight;

- 3. Only the personnel of the Slaughterhouse shall conduct the butchering of the hogs and must avoid contact with the meat handlers/butchers coming from Laoag City.
- 4. All fees and charges collected for SN butchers shall also apply for LC butchers.
- 5. The observance of the minimum health standards such as physical distancing (approximately 2 meters), wearing of facemask and face shield, and frequent handwashing will be strictly implemented.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Mayor or his authorized representative is given authority thru this resolution to deny entry of hogs including the meat handlers and butchers if upon his judgment, the rules and guidelines imposed had been violated He shall call the attention of the PNP to ensure the strict and smooth implementation of the above-mentioned measures.

WHEREAS, after thorough deliberation and consideration of the members of the Sangguniang Bayan, it was:

RESOLVED as it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to Prescribe Rules and Guidelines in Allowing Meat Handlers of Laoag City or their Authorized Representatives to have their Hogs Butchered at the Municipal Abattoir of the Municipality of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to transcribe copies of this resolution to the Local Chief Executive and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action;


On motion of Member Luciano R. Caraang, duly seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.
