“RESOLUTION NO. 2021-32

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE WILLIAM DAR, SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, THRU DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE REGIONAL DIRECTOR NESTOR D. DOMENDEN, FUNDING ALLOCATION IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF SIXTY EIGHT MILLION PESOS (PHP68,000,000.00) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF FARM-TO-MARKET ROADS AND DREDGING OF THE SMALL WATER IMPOUNDING PROJECTS (SWIPs) LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, ILOCOS NORTE.

WHEREAS, it is imperative for the Local Government Unit to draw the road map aimed to improve the quality of life of its inhabitants, pursuant to Section 16 and 17 of the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, consistent with the National Government's program of poverty alleviation, the municipality has adopted plans and programs to address the needs of the farmers to enhance their earning capacity and ultimately improve their quality of life;

WHEREAS, one of the priority concerns of the present administration is the rehabilitation and construction of Farm-to-Market Road and SWIPs within the municipality which will in the end redounds to the benefit of the citizens especially the farmers and traders;

WHEREAS, component of this program is the construction of Farm to Market Roads and dredging of the SWIPs and if implemented will result in increase of production and income of these farm cultivators;

WHEREAS, most of these plans remain unimplemented due to the inadequate resources of the Municipal Government, hence the LGU is constrained to seek the assistance of National Government agencies tasked in the implementation of the agricultural programs;

RESOLVED, as is hereby RESOLVED to Earnestly Requesting the Honorable William Dar, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, Thru Department of Agriculture Regional Director Nestor D. Domenden, Funding Allocation in the total amount of Sixty Eight Million Pesos (Php68,000,000.00) for the Construction of Farm-To-Market Roads located in the Municipality of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte, these Farm-to-Market Roads and dredging of the Small Water Impounding Projects (SWIPs) needed as follow:

1. Dedging of Samac SWIP	Php5,000,000.00
2. Dedging of Sto. Tomas SWIP	Php5,000,000.00
3. Dedging of Bingao SWIP	Php5,000,000.00
4. Dedging of San Pablo SWIP	Php5,000,000.00
5. Dedging of San Agustin SWIP	Php5,000,000.00
6. Dedging of Catuguing SWIP	Php5,000,000.00
7. Construction of Farm-to-Market Road Brgy.16, San Marcos.	Php30,000,000.00
8. Construction of Farm-to-Market Road Brgy.18, San Pedro.	Php8,000,000.00
	Php68,000,000.00


