“RESOLUTION NO. 2021-125

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT (DOLE) THROUGH REGIONAL OFFICE 1 FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GOVERNMENT INTERNSHIP PROGRAM (GIP).

WHEREAS, the DOLE through RO 1 and the LGU of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte have agreed to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding for the purpose of achieving the goals of the Government Internship Program of the DOLE, that is, to provide opportunities and engage program beneficiaries to serve the general public in government agencies/entities at the national and local level;

WHEREAS, the DOLW through RO 1, as the implementor of the GIP undertakes to provide and assign the interns/beneficiaries to the LGU San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte to perform tasks and duties within those prescribed under Department Order No. 204, Series of 2019;

WHEREAS, Sec. 22(c) of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, provides, that:

Sec. 22. Corporate Powers. – (a) Every local government unit, as a corporation, shall have the following powers:

xxx

xxx

xxx

(c) Unless otherwise provided in this Code, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the sanggunian concerned. A legible copy of such contract shall be posted at a conspicuous place in the provincial capitol or the city, municipal or barangay hall.

WHEREAS, the municipal mayor is empowered by the same Code to enter into contracts on behalf of the municipality, based on Section 444(b)(1)(vi) thereof which provides:

Section 444. The Chief Executive: Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation.
– xxx

(b) For efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code, the municipal mayor shall:

(vi) Upon authorization by the sangguniang bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance.”

WHEREAS, after thorough deliberation and consideration of the members of the Sangguniang Bayan, it was:

RESOLVED as it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to authorize the Local Chief Executive to Enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) for the implementation of the Government Internship Program (GIP).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to transcribe copies of this resolution to the Local Chief Executive and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action;

On motion of Member Jessie Julito P. Pumaras, Sr., duly seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.
