BARTOLOME RETIRED SCHOOL PRINCIPAL IV OF SAN NICOLAS NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL- BINGAO CAMPUS IN RECOGNITION AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF HIS EXEMPLARY PERFORMANCE AND CONTRIBUTION TO THE EDUCATION OF YOUNG SAN NICOLENSES DURING HIS STINT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Municipal Ordinance No. 2009-12, the Municipal Government of Nicolas shall accord a Necrological Service to honor sons and daughters of the town who have rendered public and exemplary service to the community;
