“RESOLUTION NO. 2022-205

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, ILOCOS NORTE IN A STATE OF STABLE INTERNAL PEACE AND SECURITY AND READY FOR MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 70 provides for the institutionalization of the Whole-Nation Approach in attaining inclusive and sustainable peace, creation of National Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict, and directs for the formulation of a National Peace Framework;

WHEREAS, the Whole-Nation Approach Addresses the root causes of insurgency, internal disturbances and tensions, and other armed conflicts and threat by prioritizing and harmonizing the delivery of basic services and social development packages by the government, facilitating societal inclusivity, and ensuring active participants of all sectors of the society in the pursuit of peace agenda;

WHEREAS, to ensure convergence and coherence in the implementation of Executive Order No. 70, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) has issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-125 as guidelines for LGU's in the establishment of Local Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict at local views;

WHEREAS, the Regional Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict 1 through Joint RDC-1 and RTF-ELCAC 1 Resolution No. 1, Series of 2022 dated February 17, 2022, has declared Ilocos Region in a state of Stable Internal Peace and Security;

WHEREAS, Region 1 has established and reached the Stable Internal Peace and Security Status for the whole 2021 and satisfied all conditions set forth by the Revised Joint Implementing Rules and Regulations to Executive Order No. 110, Series of 1999;

WHEREAS, the continued efforts of the Ilocos Norte Police Provincial Office, Delta Coy, 24th Infantry battalion, 7th Infantry Division of the Armed Forces of the Philippines, Provincial/Municipal DILG, and the San Nicolas Municipal Poolice Station, of the Peace, Law Enforcement, and Development Support (PLLEDS) cluster of the MTF-ELCAC, Ilocos Norte, the Communist Terrorist Group (CTGs) operating within the barangay has been dismantled;

WHEREAS, the declaration of the Municipality of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte in a Stable Internal Peace and Security will promote economic growth, political stability as well foster unity among peace-loving citizens therein;

RESOLVED as it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to Declare the Municipality of San Nicolas, Ilocos Norte in a State of Stable Internal Peace and Security and Ready for Municipal Development.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to transcribe copies of this resolution to the Local Chief Executive and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action;


On motion of Member Norberto S. Dadiz, Jr., duly seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.
