“RESOLUTION NO. 2022-242

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE TO REPRESENT THE MUNICIPALITY AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY AND THE MARIANO MARCOS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AND MEDICAL CENTER (MMM&MC) FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE VOLUNTARY BLOOD SERVICES PROGRAM PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT 7719 OR THE NATIONAL VOLUNTARY BLOOD SERVICES ACT OF 1994.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7719, otherwise known as the “National Voluntary Blood Services Act of 1994” was passed and enacted in order to pursue the State’s goal of attaining the objectives of the National Voluntary Blood Program of the government;

WHEREAS, as one of the declared policy of Republic Act No. 7719 is to mobilize all sectors of the community to participate in mechanism for voluntary non-profit collection of blood;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of San Nicolas must be involved actively in the implementation of the provisions of Republic Act No. 7719, to encourage community participation and to proceed with vigor the ultimate attainment of the objectives envisioned under the said law;

WHEREAS, it is declared policy of the Municipality of San Nicolas to give priority to health development to its members through the provision and delivery of health services;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforementioned policy, the Municipality of San Nicolas is committed to provide medical assistance to its members when necessary if blood transfusion is needed during confinements in hospitals by providing them voluntary donors;

WHEREAS, a considerable number of patients coming from the province who require blood during their confinement at the hospitals, most specifically at the Mariano Marcos Memorial Hospital and Medical Center, have been recipients of the Municipality of San Nicolas;

WHEREAS, a concomitant of the avowed policies of Republic Act No. 7719, coupled with the need to have a blood collection/pool in the Province of Ilocos Norte, the Municipality of San Nicolas enters into a Memorandum of Agreement, wherein the Mariano Marcos Memorial Hospital and Medical Center will serve as the blood bank of the units collected during the mobile blood donation activities.

WHEREAS, Sec. 22(c) of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, provides, that:

Sec. 22. Corporate Powers. – (a) Every local government unit, as a corporation, shall have the following powers:

xxx xxx xxx

(c) Unless otherwise provided in this Code, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the sanggunian concerned. A legible copy of such contract shall be posted at a conspicuous place in the provincial capitol or the city, municipal or barangay hall;

WHEREAS, the municipal mayor is empowered by the same Code to enter into contracts on behalf of the municipality, based on Section 444(b)(1)(vi) thereof which provides:

Section 444. The Chief Executive: Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation. – xxx

(b) For efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code, the municipal mayor shall:


(vi) Upon authorization by the sangguniang bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance.”

WHEREAS, after thorough deliberation and consideration of the members of the Sangguniang Bayan, it was:

RESOLVED as it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to authorize the Local Chief Executive to represent the municipality and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Municipality and the Mariano Marcos Memorial Hospital and Medical Center (MMM&MC) for the implementation of the Voluntary Blood Services Program Pursuant to the Provisions of Republic Act 7719 or the National Voluntary Blood Services Act of 1994.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to transcribe copies of this resolution to the Local Chief Executive and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action;

On motion of Member Moera Joy N. Galing-Luna, duly seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.
