“MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2022-20

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE BASIC QUALIFICATION OF PLAYERS WHO WILL PARTICIPATE IN THE DAMILI FESTIVAL INTER-BARANGAY BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT”

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 19 (1) of the 1987 Constitution provides that “The State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry”;

WHEREAS, San Nicoleños are sports enthusiasts and the municipality has produced excellent athletes in the national competitions, either as amateur or professional athletes;

WHEREAS, the municipal government recognizes that sports development will effectively address the need for a comprehensive grassroots sports program centered on values formation inherent in the practice of sports and play (e.g. patriotism, nationalism, self-discipline, respect for law and order, hardwork, teamwork, camaraderie, sportsmanship and fair play), thus, preventing a child’s chances of becoming a juvenile delinquent;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Sports of the municipality has been encountering problems or issues on age qualifications and residency requirement every time it holds a basketball tournament;

WHEREAS, to address the situation, there is a need to define the basic qualification of players who will participate in the Damili Festival Inter-Barangay Basketball Tournament;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan in session duly assembled, that:

Page 2, Municipal Ordinance No. 2022-20;

SECTION 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall be known as an “Ordinance Defining the Basic Qualification of Players Who Will Participate in the Damili Festival Inter-Barangay Basketball Tournament.”

SECTION 2. Coverage. – Damili Festival Inter-Barangay Basketball Tournament shall pertain to the basketball games played by the members of the Sangguniang Kabataan.

SECTION 3. Qualifications of Players. – Players who will compete in the Damili Festival Inter-Barangay Basketball Tournament must possess the following requirement.

- a. Age – A player must be at least 15 years of age but not more than 24 years of age prior to November 1.
- b. Registered Voter – A player must be registered voter of the Barangay where he seeks to represent at least Three (3) months prior to November 1. For this purpose, he must submit a copy of his Voter’s Registration Record duly certified by the COMELEC to the Damili Festival Sports Committee.
- c. Residency – For purposes of this ordinance, a player is considered a resident of the Barangay if he is a Registered Voter of the said Barangay, regardless of where he actually resides.

For purposes of the Damili Festival 2022, players must be registered voters of the barangays they represent two months before November 1.

SECTION 4. Violations. – Failure to comply or violations to the requirements set forth shall be a ground for the automatic disqualification of players.

Any player who is found out using other’s identity shall be suspended and automatically be blacklisted in any Damili Festival basketball competition and all the game/s he played by the team he represents shall be declared lost and the team shall be automatically out from the league.

SECTION 5. Penalties. – Any person who caused the inclusion of the disqualified player from playing during the tournament shall be held liable as follows:

- a. First offense – One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P1,500.00);
- b. Second offense – Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00);
- c. Third offense – Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00)

SECTION 6. Separability Clause. – If for any reason, any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgment or action shall not affect or impair the other sections or provisions thereof.

SECTION 7. Repealing Clause. – All ordinances, rules and regulations, or part thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. Effectivity. – This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.


