“RESOLUTION NO. 2022-273

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE MUNICIPAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2022-01 ENTITLED, “A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ILOCOS NORTE HEADED BY HONORABLE GOVERNOR MATTHEW J. MARCOS-MANOTOC FOR THE UTILIZATION OF THE TAKUAT TRAINING CENTER ISOLATION FACILITY AS BALAY SILANGAN FOR THE REFORMATION OF DRUG PERSONALITIES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, PROVINCE OF ILOCOS NORTE”.

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government issued Memorandum Circular No. 2009-09 (Subject: Unified Actions Against Illegal Drugs and other Substances), which mandates that it is a principal responsibility of the local authorities to support all government efforts to address illegal drugs and other substances;

WHEREAS, the Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB) issued Board Regulation No. 02 series of 2018, otherwise known as Balay Silangan Initiative, specifically providing guidelines for community involvement in reforming drug offenders into self-sufficient and law-abiding members of the society;

WHEREAS, DDB Board Regulation No. 02 has mandated the local government to provide interventions that shall include, but not limited to, education and health, psychological/spiritual/physical activities, and livelihood or employment education;

WHEREAS, the same Board Regulation has also mandated the networking and establishment of necessary infrastructures for the programs, and the allocation of financial and logistical support needed to program beneficiaries;

WHEREAS, in consideration of the drug personalities who voluntarily surrendered to authorities but are not drug users, those who have availed of the plea bargaining agreement or convicted under Section 15 of Republic Act 9165 and are required to undergo Drug Reformation Program serving as an alternative intervention and those who served jail terms for violation of the Act, the members of the Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council have been empowered to establish the Balay Silangan which shall serve as a Reformation Center;

WHEREAS, the municipal government, as of this time, cannot provide for the establishment of the Balay Silangan due to time constraints and the timelines set forth by the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency on Drug Clearing Activities and the Seal of Good Local Governance;

WHEREAS, the MADAC has considered the Takuat Training Center, particularly the building which served as Quarantine/Isolation Facility during the height of the COVID-19 Pandemic in the province, to be used as Balay Silangan for the municipality;

WHEREAS, there is a need to request the Provincial Government of Ilocos Norte through Hon. Governor Matthew J. Marcos-Manotoc for the utilization of such facility of the provincial government;

WHEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to support the Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council Resolution No. 2022-01 entitled, "A Resolution requesting the Provincial Government of Ilocos Norte through Honorable Governor Matthew J. Marcos-Manotoc for the utilization of the Takuat Training Center Isolation Facility to serve as Balay Silangan for the reformation of the drug personalities of the Municipality of San Nicolas, Province of Ilocos Norte".

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to transcribe copies of this resolution to the Hon. Governor Matthew J. Marcos-Manotoc and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action;

On motion of Member Norberto S. Dadiz, Jr., duly seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.
