**“RESOLUTION NO. 2022-283**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE TO REPRESENT THE MUNICIPALITY AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY AND THE DIVINE WORD COLLEGE OF LAOAG FOR THE INTERNSHIP OF THEIR STUDENTS.**

**WHEREAS**, DWCL an educational institution offers Business Programs namely: Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, Bachelor of Science in Accountancy, Bachelor of Science in Management Accounting, Bachelor of Science in Tourism Management, and Bachelor of Science in Hospitality Management;

**WHEREAS**, part of the curriculum of the students is an –on-the-job training/practicum/internship which aims to bridge the gap between theories learned in the classroom and the actual work experience;

**WHEREAS**, DWCL finds its importance to link with training partners for the development of students through a meaningful on the job training;

**WHEREAS**, Sec. 22(c) of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, provides, that:

*Sec. 22. Corporate Powers. – (a) Every local government unit, as a corporation, shall have the following powers:*

*(c) Unless otherwise provided in this Code, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the sanggunian concerned. A legible copy of such contract shall be posted at a conspicuous place in the provincial capitol or the city, municipal or barangay hall;*

**WHEREAS**, the municipal mayor is empowered by the same Code to enter into contracts on behalf of the municipality, based on Section 444(b)(1)(vi) thereof which provides:

*Section 444. The Chief Executive: Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation.*

(b) For efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code, the municipal mayor shall:

(vi) Upon authorization by the sangguniang bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance.”

**WHEREAS**, after thorough deliberation and consideration of the members of the Sangguniang Bayan, it was:

**RESOLVED** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to authorize the Local Chief Executive to represent the municipality and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Municipality and the Divine Word College of Laoag for the Internship of their Students.

**RESOLVED, FURTHER**, to transcribe copies of this resolution to the Local Chief Executive and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action;

On motion of Member Luciano R. Caraang, duly seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.
