“RESOLUTION NO. 2022-299

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE TO REPRESENT THE MUNICIPALITY AND SIGN THE CONTRACT OF AFFILIATION/MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITY AND THE NORTHWESTERN UNIVERSITY (NWU) BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING (BSN) FOR THEIR CLINICAL AFFILIATION.

WHEREAS, the municipality agrees and allows the affiliation and training of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) students of the NWU subject to the policies, procedures and guidelines governing Affiliation and Training of students in the Department of Health/Hospitals/Rural Health Units and other health agencies, and that the Chief of the Agency representing the municipality shall be responsible and liable to the fullest extent for any violation of the provisions in Administrative Order No. 5-A series of 1996. Likewise, the NWU shall strictly comply with the provisions of the above Administrative Order and any violation thereof shall be a legitimate ground for the cancellation of the contract;

WHEREAS, that the officiating students of the NWU shall pay the corresponding amounts in compliance with the Standards Rates of Affiliation Fees for Nursing Students as provided for in DOH Administrative Order No. 5-A, Series of 1996, Section 917;

WHEREAS, that the affiliating students and the clinical instructors of the NWU shall be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as a requirement prior to the affiliation and training of the students;

WHEREAS, that the minimum health protocols are to be strictly observed by the affiliating students and the clinical instructors of the NWU once they are inside the healthcare facility of the municipality.

WHEREAS, Sec. 22(c) of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, provides, that:

Sec. 22. Corporate Powers. – (a) Every local government unit, as a corporation, shall have the following powers:

xxx

xxx

(c) Unless otherwise provided in this Code, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive in behalf of the local government unit without prior authorization by the sanggunian concerned. A legible copy of such contract shall be posted at a conspicuous place in the provincial capitol or the city, municipal or barangay hall;

WHEREAS, the municipal mayor is empowered by the same Code to enter into contracts on behalf of the municipality, based on Section 444(b)(1)(vi) thereof which provides:

Section 444. The Chief Executive: Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation.
– xxx

(b) For efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code, the municipal mayor shall:

(vi) Upon authorization by the sangguniang bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance.”

WHEREAS, after thorough deliberation and consideration of the members of the Sangguniang Bayan, it was:

RESOLVED as it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to authorize the Local Chief Executive to represent the municipality and sign the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the municipality and the Northwestern University (NWU) Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) for their Clinical Affiliation.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to transcribe copies of this resolution to the Local Chief Executive and all concerned, for their information and appropriate action;


On motion of Member Luciano R. Caraang, duly seconded, foregoing resolution was unanimously approved.
