“MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2022-26

AN ORDINANCE IDENTIFYING THE PUNISHABLE ACTS/CONDUCT OF PERSONS IN THE CONDUCT OF INTER-BARANGAY BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN NICOLAS, PROVINCE OF ILOCOS NORTE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREOF”

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 19 (1) of the 1987 Constitution provides that “The State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry”;

WHEREAS, San Nicoleños are sports enthusiasts and the municipality has produced excellent athletes in the national competitions, either as amateur or professional athletes;

WHEREAS, the municipal government recognizes that sports development will effectively address the need for a comprehensive grassroots sports program centered on values formation inherent in the practice of sports and play (e.g. patriotism, nationalism, self-discipline, respect for law and order, hardwork, teamwork, camaraderie, sportsmanship and fair play), thus, preventing a child’s chances of becoming a juvenile delinquent;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall be known as an “Ordinance Identifying the Punishable Acts/Conduct of Persons in the Conduct of Inter-Barangay Basketball Tournament within the Municipality of San Nicolas, Province of Ilocos Norte and Providing Penalties Thereof.”

SECTION 2. Application. – This ordinance shall apply in the conduct of the Damili Festival Inter-Barangay Basketball Tournament played by the members of the Katipunan ng Kabataan.

SECTION 3. Penalties for Misconduct.

A. MISCONDUCT BY A PLAYER.

1. Taunting an opponent.
 - a. First offense – Ejected from the current game and suspension on the succeeding 1 game;
 - b. Second offense – Ejected from the current game and suspension on the succeeding 2 games;
 - c. Third offense – Ejected and no longer allowed to play on succeeding games.

2. Received a flagrant foul and is ejected from the game for contacting an official in a disrespectful manner or in such a manner as to indicate resentment.
 - a. First offense – Ejected from the current game and suspension on the succeeding 2 games;
 - b. Second offense – Ejected from the current game and suspension for the entire duration of the tournament.

3. Receives a flagrant foul and is ejected from the game for fighting. Fighting includes but is not limited to acts such as.
 1. Striking an opponent with a fist, hands, legs or feet;
 2. Instigating a fight by committing unsportsmanlike act toward an opponent that causes an opponent to retaliate by fighting.
 - a. First offense – Ejected from the current game and suspension for the entire duration of the tournament.

4. Engages in a fight outside the duration of the game but within the jurisdiction of the management committee.
 - a. First offense –suspension of 2 games;
 - b. Second offense –suspension of 4 games;
 - c. Third offense – minimum suspension 3 months.

5. Assault on game official by deliberate physical contact i.e. pushing, pulling, charging, striking, spitting, kicking or any form of violent contact or attempted violent contact or attempted physical contact or threatening.
 - a. First offense –suspension of 1 year;

- b. Second offense –suspension of 3 years;
- c. Third offense –suspension of 5 years.

B. MISCONDUCT BY A TEAM OFFICIAL.

1. Ejected from the game for disrespectfully taunting a member of the opposing team.
 - a. First offense –suspension of 1 game;
 - b. Second offense –suspensions of 2 game;
 - c. Third offense –suspension of 6 games.

2. Engages in a fight outside the duration of the game but within the jurisdiction of the game management committee.
 - a. First offense – suspension of 2 games;
 - b. Second offense –suspension of 4 games;
 - c. Third offense – suspension of 3 months.

3. Ejected from the game for intentionally or flagrantly contacting a member of the opposing team.
 - a. First offense – suspension of 2 games;
 - b. Second offense – suspension of 4 games;
 - c. Third offense – suspension of 10 months.

4. Receives an unsportsmanlike technical foul and ejected from the game for disrespectfully addressing or contacting an official or gesturing in such a manner as to indicate resentment.
 - a. First offense – suspension of 2 games;
 - b. Second offense – suspension of 4 games.

5. Receives a flagrant foul and is ejected from the game for fighting. Fighting includes but not limited to acts such as.
 1. An attempt to strike an opponent with a first, hands, legs or feet
 2. Ant attempt to instigate a fight by committing unsportsmanlike act toward an opponent the causes an opponent to retaliate by fighting.
 3. An attempt to punch or kick an opponent, contact not necessary
 - a. First offense –suspension of 2 games;
 - b. Second offense –suspension of 5 games;
 - c. Third offense – suspension of 3 months.





- 6. Assault on game official by deliberate physical contact i.e pushing, pulling, charging, striking, spitting, kicking or any form of violent contact, or attempted violent contact or attempted physical contact or threatening.

SECTION 4. Additional Guidelines.

- a) A player must play in only one team during the tournament and is not allowed to play in the Inter-Agency Basketball Tournament. Violation of this rule is subject for disqualification in joining the tournament;
- b) Any barangay official, personnel or spectator who commits disrespectful acts towards the committee, management and referees and deliberately inflicts violence with the opposing team shall be escorted out of the venue. In addition, he/she may be dealt with appropriate charges and a fine without prejudice to the filing of appropriate charges in the courts of competent jurisdiction;
- c) In the event that a decision cannot be made due to lack of evidence that would provide necessary information in delivering the right decision, a video record/footage available can be accepted as an alternate evidence by the officiating officials;
- d) Any player/team official found out to be engaged in illegal betting supported by clear evidence, shall be a ground of disciplinary action without prejudice to the filing of appropriate charges in the courts of competent jurisdiction.

SECTION 5. Separability Clause. – If for any reason, any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgment or action shall not affect or impair the other sections or provisions thereof.

SECTION 6. Repealing Clause. – All ordinances, rules and regulations, or part thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. Effectivity. – This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
