**“RESOLUTION NO. 2023-149**

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Narvais-Galing is a known disciplinarian, committed and a patient mentor and to her peers, she is a source of inspiration especially to the young and aspiring teachers;

**WHEREAS**, she has always exemplified modesty and godness and even served as a Barangay Health Worker in her community, a loving wife, and mother of three who were all educated, indeed a kind-hearted woman, always ready to lend a helping hand;

**WHEREAS**, her death is a great loss not only to her immediate family but to the entire municipality, and the people of San Nicolas shall always remember the loyalty and commitment she exhibited as a teacher and a wife, worthy of emulation;

**WHEREFORE**, be it RESOLVED as it is hereby RESOLVED by the Sangguniang Bayan assembled in session, to express the sincerest sympathy and condolences of the people of San Nicolas to the bereaved family of the late Mrs. Jean Narvais Galing.
